The McCORMICK line will be handled from here by the "ARA", a Subsidiary Company of the Oesterreichische Landwirtestelle, who is also taking over our office and warehouse and also, at very good salaries, Mr. STURM, Mr. KALTENECKER, Mr. LOHSE, and our office boy FRANK, whereas Mr. SIMON joins our new DEERING jobbers, the "GARBE", which again is a Subsidiary Company of the BRITISH-MAGYAR BANK, and which was formerly the OESTERREICHISCH-UNGARISCHE MASCHINEN-HANDELSGESELL-SCHAFT, whose Director SZASZ, I think, is known to you. Our English stenographer, Miss BARON, joins the VACUUM OIL COMPANY, also at a very good salary. So we are all placed, except Mr. TOMASEK, who probably will be transferred to CZECHO-SLOVAKIA.
