RE CRANK CASE-45HP ENGINE.

We are in receipt of your favor of April 13th, referring to the difficulty, which Mr. Stefek experienced in connection with the operation with the Graf Koziembrodzki engine, which appears to be due to the use of poor oil and the presence of scales in the crank chamber. We have no doubt that you examined both of these engines carefully while at Breslau.

The trouble that has developed with the Koziembrodzki tractor indicates, that it is necessary to give this subject further attention that is, the crank case should be examined perhaps daily for 3 or 4 days after the engine has been started, as it is quite probable that some scales would be jared loose, owing to the operation of the engine, which were not discoverable when the engine was being set up, or after it had been operated for a few hours only. This circumstance simply emphasises, how necessary it is to be careful.
